

Mr. Moreland asked if there were any plans for improvement at Centerville Road at Opportunity Way. Mr. Vinciguerra stated that the school district is working on a pedestrian accommodation plan for that intersection.

Mr. Moreland asked about intersection improvements at Centerville and Longhill Road. Mr. Vinciguerra responded that plan is to add turn lanes, a traffic light and a bike lane at the intersection and it should be complete by the fall.

Mr. Turnbull stated that as the chair, he will write a letter of support for Country Road to be used as a bike route and for any County/City projects that bike friendly. He also noted the upcoming Pedal the Parkway event.

Mr. Cherry stated that the manhole at 199/Jamestown Road has sunk and is a hazard for cyclists.

Ms. Carter noted the importance in getting involved in County/City Comprehensive Plans updates early to have the most impact on future development.

Mr. Vinciguerra and Ms. Parker stated they will discuss how comprehensive plan and zoning ordinance updates work at the next meeting.

PABAC MEETING

The committee discussed the February 17th PABAC meeting and the meeting schedule for the remainder of the year. Luke Vinciguerra stated that PABAC meetings are only called when enough agenda items are accumulated and meetings were irregular.
