



Historical Committee to commemorate Veteran's Day at York Hall

In remembrance of Veteran's Day 2009, the York County Historical Committee will observe the occasion with a memorial service at the monument in front of York Hall, 301 Main Street, Yorktown, on Wednesday, Nov. 11.

The monument at York Hall honors the residents of York County who gave what President Lincoln called, "the last full measure of devotion."

The service will begin at noon and will include a tolling of the bell, presentation of the colors, singing of the National Anthem, Pledge of Allegiance, laying of honors, and "Taps." This year's keynote speaker will be Lt. Gen. Michael A. Vane, Deputy Commanding General, Futures/Director, Army Capabilities Integration Center, United States Army Training and Doctrine Command, Fort Monroe, Virginia. Lt. Gen. Vane has over 30 years of active duty service. Distinguished guests will include The Honorable Rob Wittman, United States House of Representatives, 1st Congressional District of Virginia.
