The market is located on the banks of the York River between Buckner and Ballard Streets at Riverwalk Landing in historic Yorktown. The markets continue on the following Saturdays: Sept. 12 & 26; Oct. 10; Nov. 14; Dec. 12. The market will be open from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

The market features an abundance of local produce, fresh seafood and meat, baked goods, gourmet herbs & spices, plants, cut flowers, baked goods, organic items, handmade soaps & lotions, pasta, sauces and more. Quality art and live musical entertainment are also featured.
