



## Swing into Spring at Riverwalk Landing, May 19 - 21

**Yorktown, May 16--**A number of ongoing activities will occur at Riverwalk Landing May 19-21 to help ring in the season and celebrate National Tourism Week. The weekend promises a full schedule of activities and entertainment. The Riverwalk Landing businesses will provide free drawings, special discounts, sidewalk sales and much more.

**Colonial Fiber Arts** will host spinning demonstrations in colonial garb; **Claire Murray** will have a caricature artist on site and a hearts and flowers rug sale; **Studio Foray** is providing free drawings for upcoming bead classes; **Ben & Jerry's/Green Mountain Coffee** will offer a 20% discount all three days; **Nicks Riverwalk Restaurant** will offer coupons for free dessert or appetizer for a future visit, as well as a drawing for dinner for two; **Viccellio Goldsmith** will host free drawings for "Sailor's Valentines" – Sterling silver and 14k gold miniatures of the love tokens that seafaring sailors of long ago brought home to their sweethearts; **Yorktown Onion** offers 10% off total purchase; **Yorktown Republic** offers a free drawing for Maui Jim sunglasses, a retail value of \$200; **Kinks & Quirks Contemporary Handcrafts** will celebrate its grand opening; and **Stars & Stripes Forever** will have sidewalk sales featuring all things patriotic.

The **Watermen's Museum** will host a class on Waterfowl Carving by Richard "Sandy" Stromberg. Visitors are welcome to view his work and watch the carving of an antique swan. Sandy will hold the class on the art of wildlife carving on Saturday and Sunday, May 19 and 20 from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. behind the Watermen's Museum.

Strolling entertainment will be available Saturday beginning at 11:30 a.m., with a performance by the **Doorway Singers**, singing doo-wop 50's and swing with a contagious energy that captures audiences of all ages. From 2 to 4 p.m., enjoy **The QuaDruba Tuba Quartet**, featuring a delightful array of music from Renaissance to Ragtime, Baroque to Bluegrass and beyond. The day's entertainment will conclude with a performance by **Trio Locordia**, featuring sing along favorites from 4 to 6 p.m.

Music continues Sunday, beginning at 12 p.m., in the Riverwalk Landing breezeway, with a performance by **Doc and Dan**, featuring music from the 60's and 70's, including Jimmy Buffett selections. From 2 to 4 p.m., join us for a performance by **Two Can Jam** playing Caribbean-style steel drum music in the Riverwalk Landing breezeway.

Children's activities, including face painting, balloon animals and other activities will be available on Saturday and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., located in the courtyard next to Kinks & Quirks Contemporary Handcrafts.

Trolley rides around historic Yorktown will be enhanced on Saturday and Sunday with a character program featuring Sarah Osborn, who carried "eats and treats" to soldiers in

the trenches during the Siege of Yorktown. Following the character program, an overview of historic Yorktown including the significance of the Revolutionary War and interpretation of each stop throughout town will be provided. The Yorktown Trolley runs daily, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.; however, the special programming on the trolley will be Saturday from 2 to 5 p.m. and Sunday, 1 to 5 p.m.

All events are free and open to the public. Guests are encouraged to bring blankets and/or lawn chairs for musical performances. Event parking is available at Riverwalk Landing in the two-level parking terrace. Additional parking is available in Yorktown at York Hall, Administration Building and the Courthouse/Finance Building Complex - all within 2 blocks from the waterfront. Look for "Event Parking" signs.
