



Yorktown Fourth of July Parade Begins at 11 a.m.

Yorktown, June 13—The annual Fourth of July Parade in Yorktown will begin at 11 a.m. The parade route begins at the intersection of Zweybrucken Road and Main Street, near the Yorktown Monument, where one of two reviewing stands are located. Units will proceed down historic Main Street to Ballard Street, turning right on Ballard Street towards the Waterfront. Once they arrive at Water Street, they will turn left and travel through Riverwalk Landing where the second reviewing stand is located. The parade will end at the Yorktown Victory Center. New this year is the addition of a float competition.

Spectators are encouraged to arrive in Yorktown by 10 a.m. to avoid the traditionally heavy traffic associated with the parade.
