



Parking and Shuttle Services for the Yorktown Fourth of July Celebration

Yorktown, June 20—Cook Road and the Colonial Parkway will offer the only two means of vehicular access for the public into and out of Yorktown on July 4th. All public parking for the event will be in the National Park Service Battlefield area at the Cook Road and Ballard Street intersections. Parking is free.

Shuttle bus services will operate from the Battlefield parking area from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. (services will cease for the 11 a.m. parade). Shuttle services will commence at the conclusion of the parade and operate from 12:30 p.m. until 5 p.m. Shuttle buses are handicapped accessible and free.

The shuttle route will make several stops throughout Yorktown including the National Park Service Visitor Center and the Watermen's Museum (this stop also services guests wishing to visit the Yorktown waterfront).

Handicapped Parking

Handicapped visitors can park in the National Park Service Visitor Center and the lower deck of the Riverwalk Landing parking terrace. People accessing the handicapped parking at the Visitor Center parking area should use Alexander Hamilton Blvd.; for the Riverwalk Landing parking terrace, take Mathews Street to Water Street.
