



## **Eleventh Annual Virginia Symphony Concert in Historic Yorktown Scheduled for September 1**

**Yorktown, August 1--**The Virginia Symphony's 11<sup>th</sup> annual free outdoor concert, under the baton of Matthew Kraemer, returns to Historic Yorktown at 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, September 1.

The performance will be held at the Yorktown Victory Monument this year. Attendees are encouraged to arrive early with lawn chairs and picnic baskets. The award-winning Fifes and Drums of York Town will provide a pre-concert performance at 6 p.m. Vendors will be on site with light picnic fare, hot dogs, desserts and soft drinks. The Celebrate Yorktown Committee will be selling Yorktown memorabilia.

There will be signs directing vehicles to public parking where free handicapped-accessible trolley service to the concert site will be available from 5 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. and again at the conclusion of the concert. Because of the temporary closure of the National Park Service footbridge, guests parking at the National Park Service Visitor Center should be prepared to ride the trolley to the concert or take the extended walk to the Victory Monument.
