



## **Yorktown Market Days at the River Announces Fall Markets**

**Yorktown, September 17--Yorktown Market Days at the River** launched earlier this summer in June with more than 14 vendors and over 200 customers. The Market is located on the banks of the York River between Buckner and Ballard Streets at Riverwalk Landing. Markets continue this fall from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the following **Saturdays: September 22, October 13, November 17 and December 8.** The market features local produce, fresh meat and seafood, baked goods, herbs, specialty cut flowers, handmade soaps, live musical entertainment and quality art.
