**York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office
Makes Arrest in Home Invasion Case**

Yorktown, April 8, 2008 – At approximately 6:00 AM, this date, Scott Allen Brady wanted in connection with a Home Invasion Robbery turned himself in the Virginia Peninsula Regional Jail. Brady lists his address in the 1700 block of Penniman Road. Brady was identified as one of three suspects in this crime which occurred in the 400 block of Bypass Road in York County, Virginia. Warrants were issued for his arrest on March 25, 2008 charging him with:

- Burglary
- Malicious Wounding (3 counts)
- Armed Robbery (2 Counts)
- Abduction (3 Counts)
- Use of a Firearm in Commission of a Felony
- Possession of a Firearm by a convicted felon

Brady along with two other unidentified suspects forced their way into the residence displaying a firearm and confronted three victims inside the residence. Two of the persons inside the residence were robbed of personal property at gunpoint. All three residents were injured in this incident and were subsequently treated for minor injuries.

The York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office is continuing this investigation and further arrests are expected in this crime.
