At 01:50 AM on Friday March 21, 2008 York Poquoson Sheriff's Office deputies were called to the 100 block of Aquia Turn in York County for a possible Burglary in progress. Upon their arrival deputies began to search the area for a suspect. Witness's told 911 Dispatcher's that an unknown suspect had rummaged through their vehicles and attempted to make entry in their home. Checking the area; Deputies were flagged down by a homeowner. He told Deputies that he had given chase to a suspect who had entered his residence. At 02:22 AM another call of a burglary in progress came in. Deputies immediately responded to the 100 block of Wicomico Turn. While searching the surrounding area deputies observed activity coming from a residence that seemed suspicious. Deputies surrounded the area and apprehended a suspect running from a residence after a brief foot pursuit.
