


EDUCATION OUTCOMES 2022-2023

- Children will demonstrate increasing ability to identify, label, describe, and manage emotions.






- Children will demonstrate increasing ability to manipulate a variety of objects requiring small muscle coordination.




- Children will be able to express themselves by engaging with others through creative role play.





Approaches to Learning (Mathematics):




- Children will demonstrate increasing ability to count to 10, connecting number words and symbols to objects counted, with the awareness that the last number describes the total.




York County Head Start Outcomes Program Wide 2022-2023

3 Year Olds: % Meeting or Exceeding Widely Held Expectations







Outcomes - Gender - Preschool 4 - Fall 2022-2023




