13 Waller Mill Park
901 Airport Road (757) 259-3778
This beautiful park is close to everything and a community favorite. Overlooking a 343-acre lake, the park provides a variety of outdoor activities from boating to hiking to fishing. **What to do:** Fishing, boating, boat ramp, fishing, pie, picnicking, hiking, and playgrounds. **Rentals:** Canoes, kayaks, pedal boats, row boats, boats w/electric motors.

14 York River State Park
5526 Riverview Road (757) 566-3036
Experience the environment of a coastal estuary. This park is known for its rare and delicate environment, where freshwater and saltwater meet to create a habitat rich in marine and plant life. Access to Taskinas Creek and York River. **What to do:** Fishing, boating, hiking, bridge trails, biking, interpretive programs, canoe trips (including moonlight trips), ghost night hikes, picnicking, and shelters. **Rentals:** Canoes, kayaks, jonboats, bicycles, paddleboats.

15 Yorktown Waterfront
Water Street, Yorktown (757) 890-3500
On the York River at historic Yorktown, this beachfront offers a relaxing day for everyone whether it's fishing, relaxing in the sun or picnicking in the beach picnic area. Perfect for families in a peaceful, no-hassle setting. Adjacent to Riverwalk Landing.

16 Little Creek Reservoir Park
180 Lakeview Road, (757) 566-1702
This park provides a variety of outdoor activities from boating to hiking to fishing. **What to do:** Fishing, boating, boat ramp, fishing, pie, picnicking, hiking, and playgrounds. **Rentals:** Canoes, kayaks, pedal boats, row boats, boats w/electric motors.

17 Quarterpath Park
202 Quarterpath Road off Rt. 60 East (757) 259-3760
This park includes three lighted softball fields; a 25-meter, 6-lane, z-shaped outdoor swimming pool; three all-weather tennis courts; playground equipment; and a picnic shelter area. **What to do:** Softball leagues, playground, pool, tennis, sand volleyball.

18 Powhatan Creek Park and Blueway
1831 Jamestown Road (757) 259-3221
Bring a canoe or kayak and see Jamestown Island and the James River. National Park Service and the Chesapeake Bay Chesapeake Gateways Network created by the like no one else. Powhatan Creek is part of the Program. Provides free access to Jamestown Island and the James River. **What to do:** Small boat/canoe launch with parking.

19 New Quarter Park
1000 Lakeshead Drive (757) 890-3500
New Quarter Park is next to the Colonial Parkway and close to Williamsburg; the park offers a

20 Skate Park and Multi-Use Trail
5301 Longhill Road (757) 259-3221
Ten thousand square feet of concrete jumps and ramps for skateboards and in-line skates. Helmets and protective gear recommended. Kids under 12 should be accompanied by an adult. Free. **What to do:** Skateboarding and in-line skating.

21 Mid County Park
3793 Ironbound Road (757) 229-1232
Take a break and enjoy one of the community's favorite parks. Outdoor family activities are plentiful including kidsburg, the area's largest community-built playground. **What to do:** Large playground, lighted tennis, sand volleyball and basketball courts, picnic facilities and large open spaces.

22 Little Creek Reservoir Park
180 Lakeview Road (757) 566-1702 or (757) 259-3200
Park overlooks a 996-acre reservoir that's a fisherman's paradise. Perfect for outdoor family time in the Williamsburg area. **What to do:** Fishing, boating, picnicking, canoeing, kayaking, jon boats and launch-your-own-boat ramp. **Rentals:** Canoes, kayaks, jon boats, trolling motors.

23 Greensprings Greenway Interpretive Trail
3751 John Tyler Highway (Route 5) behind Jamestown High School (757) 259-3221
Link history and nature by hiking a three-mile soft surface trail that retraces the footsteps of Virginia Indians and early colonists. Near Jamestown Island and adjacent to Mainland Farm – considered to be the oldest working farm in North America. **What to do:** Hiking w/interpretive signage.

24 Chickahominy Riverfront Park
1350 John Tyler Highway (757) 285-5020
Enjoy this 140-acre outdoor facility on the banks of the beautiful Chickahominy River. **What to do:** Camping, fishing, boating, boat ramp, fishing pier. **Rentals:** Canoes, kayaks, boats w/motors.

25 Freedom Park
5535 Centerville Road (757) 259-3221
Take a leisurely drive, walk or bike ride along the scenic 23-mile Colonial Parkway which provides a physical and metaphorical link between Jamestown, Yorktown and Williamsburg. **What to do:** Fishing, scenic driving, interpretive pulloffs, beaches, biking.

26 Colonial Parkway
Right down the road from the College of William and Mary, this passive park provides a lookout tower and marsh walkway through College Creek. **What to do:** Walkway, kayak/canoe launch, wildlife. **Rentals:** Canoes, kayaks, kayak/canoe launch, wildlife.

27 Kiwanis Municipal Park
Longhill Road (757) 259-3760
This park provides two lighted ball fields, playground equipment and a shelter with picnic tables. Seven lighted all-weather tennis courts are available to the public free on a first-come, first-served basis. **What to do:** Tennis, picnicking, organized sports.

28 Yorktown Waterfront
Water Street, Yorktown (757) 890-3500
On the York River at historic Yorktown, this beachfront offers a relaxing day for everyone whether it's fishing, relaxing in the sun or picnicking in the beach picnic area. Perfect for families in a peaceful, no-hassle setting. Adjacent to Riverwalk Landing.

29 New Quarter Park
1000 Lakeshead Drive (757) 890-3500
New Quarter Park is next to the Colonial Parkway and close to Williamsburg; the park offers a
