## Welcome!

York County is excited to begin its summer of Special Recreation Camp! A fun-filled schedule of activities in a friendly & social atmosphere has been planned! We look forward to your participation in this 4 week RECREATION based program!



## General Information

The Special Recreation Camp is a camp for ages 6-21 with a mild to moderate disability. This year's location is **Seaford Elementary School** (1105 Seaford Rd, Seaford, VA 23696). The camp will operate for 4 weeks from June 24<sup>th</sup> – July 19<sup>th</sup>, Monday through Friday 9 am to 2pm. The Camp will be closed on Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. The program fee includes daily activities, special events, and field trips. Participants should pack a bag lunch and beverage(s) every day. A typical participant:

- Should be able to independently, or with verbal cues, to feed and use the restroom on their own.
- Should have the ability to effectively communicate needs to staff members, may be verbal or with a communication device.
- Participants are able to function successfully with a 1:3 staff to camper ratio.  
One on one supervision is not provided.

**Please note** Aggressive behavior (including but not limited to biting, hitting & kicking) that endangers others is cause for dismissal from camp.

## Registration Information



Registration is required for this program and is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **There is limited space for this camp.** Registration will begin on March 4, 2019. The fee is \$225 for county resident or \$400.00 for non- county resident fee per child. There are three options to register:
