## Medicare Update

November 17 · 1 - 3 pm

The Medicare open enrollment period began October 15 and goes through December 7. Depending on your circumstances this may be the only time during the year that you may be able to enroll in or switch to another Medicare Advantage plan or Medicare Part D prescription plan. It is important to review your plan each year. A representative from the Virginia Insurance Counselina Assistance Program (VICAP) will give an overview of 2022 changes and answer vour questions on Medicare and Medicare Part D. VICAP is a free program that assists consumers 60 and over and their families with benefit issues with Medicare, Medicaid, medical bill paying and long-term care insurance.
