## York County Tropical Storm Isaias Update 3

Yorktown Waterfront/Historic Yorktown businesses prepare for TS Isaias

August 3, 2020

Riverwalk Landing, Yorktown's waterfront area, is preparing for the arrival of Tropical Storm Isaias. Visitors are encouraged to check Visit Yorktown's Facebook page ([www.facebook.com/VisitYorktown/](http://www.facebook.com/VisitYorktown/)) for a list of Historic Yorktown businesses and their hours, which will be updated throughout this evening and into tomorrow as Isaias approaches and passes through our area.

- Several Riverwalk Landing stores, restaurants, and attractions have chosen to shut their doors.
- Riverwalk Landing Piers will close to the public at 9 p.m. ahead of Tropical Storm Isaias. Any vessels in need of safe harbor in the coming hours are welcome to dock at the piers, with the understanding that there will be no staff to assist with mooring. All shore power, water, and pump-out services have been suspended and will remain off until the threat of the inclement weather has passed.
- The Yorktown Fishing Pier is closed Tuesday
- Yorktown's home-ported Schooner *Alliance* is riding out the storm at York River Yacht Haven.
- The Yorktown Trolley is suspending service Tuesday and will resume its regularly scheduled route on Wednesday as long as the roadways are clear of water and debris.
- The Beach Picnic Area is closed.
- The Gallery at York Hall and York County Historical Museum will be closed Tuesday.
