## Helpful Tidbits

### If bitten....


- Don't panic!
- Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

#### IMMEDIATELY:

- Notify your physician.
- Call Animal Services to get the animal and to report the bite.
- Notify the Health Department.



### Know the law...



- It's against the law for the owner or custodian of a dog to allow the dog to run at-large in the County at any time.
- "Running at large" means roaming, running or self-hunting off the property of its owner or custodian and not under the owner's or custodian's immediate control.

### Licensing and Lost Pets...

- Pets that have been licensed or have identity tags are 95% more likely to be returned to their owner.
- Dogs 4 months and older must be vaccinated and licensed with the County.
- Licenses are issued by the Treasurer's Office for a onetime \$10.00 fee for the animal's lifetime.
- A current rabies certificate must be presented to obtain the license.
