The canvass meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order on Wednesday, March 4, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were: Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, Registrar.

Chairman Rawls shared some observations of this election and possible areas we may address in future elections.

A security form for transfer of ballots from Williamsburg office was discussed.

(Closed Session)

At 10:12 a.m. Phillip Wolf moved to move into close session to discuss provisional ballots. Sandy Molineaux seconded the motion.

(Open Session)

At 10:55 a.m. Richard Rawls moved to go into open session. Phillip Wolf seconded.
