

August 27, 2019 Electoral Board Meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order on Tuesday, August 27, 2019, at 9:59 a.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were: Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, Registrar.

The July 2019 Board Minutes were read and approved.

Walt Latham presented an update on the status of the FY2020 budget.
The impacts of no-excuse voting are being studied by a committee in VRAV.

The registrar has been working with HR to bring new people on board to be sure we can adequately staff the Washington Square office through the November 2019 election.

Training dates have been set. All training for election officials in lower county and chiefs will occur in the Washington Square office. General election officials from the Williamsburg area will attend classes at the Griffin-Yeates Center as usual.

Most furniture for the Washington Square office should arrive September 3-4.

September 20, 2019, is beginning of absentee voting. Thursday January 16, 2020, is beginning of absentee voting for presidential primary.

Sandy Molineaux reported all board members will have their own email address. At this time, secretary email will be to position.

Richard asked Phillip to begin the Security Plan.

Richard will schedule the L&A testing dates.

Richard will complete annual review of election official training plan for York County for presentation to Board.

Information from last election is to be transferred to a thumb drive which will be maintained by Clerk of the Court.

Storage of voting equipment at Coventry School must be checked.

At present, the Ballard Street office will be used as a "satellite office".
