The canvass was called to order Monday, November 7, 2018, at 10:05 a.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were Vice-Chairman, Phillip Wolf; Secretary, Sandy Molineaux; and General Registrar, Walt Latham.

Patti Diggs and Danielle Gale, observers from the Republican Party were also in attendance. They requested copies of the provisional logs.

At 12:00 p.m. Mark Edward Kroll arrived to speak with the Electoral Board regarding his Provisional ballot. At this time, Patti Diggs and Danielle Gale left the meeting.

(Closed Session)

At 12:02 p.m. Sandy Molineaux requested a motion to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing Mr. Kroll's provisional ballot. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 12:15 p.m. Chairman Rawls moved to return to open meeting session. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote
