

November 13, 2017 General Election Canvass

The canvass was called to order Monday, November 13, 2017 at 10:02 a.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were Vice-Chairman, Phillip Wolf, and General Registrar, Walt Latham. The Vice-Chairman served as secretary.

(Closed Session)

At 10:11 a.m. Chairman Rawls requested a motion to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots submitted for the November 7, 2017 election. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 12:09 p.m. Chairman Rawls moved to return to open meeting session. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote
