ANOTHER SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION POSTED FOR SECOND SEGMENT OF I-64 WIDENING PROJECT

Motorists advised to drive with caution

NEWPORT NEWS—Starting the morning of Friday, February 17, the speed limit on Interstate 64 East from Route 199 (Humelsine Parkway, exit 242) past Lee Hall (exit 247) will be reduced to 55 miles per hour during construction of the I-64 Widening Project.

Motorists are advised to obey the reduced speed limit and drive with caution when traveling in the construction area.

A reduced speed limit is already in effect in the westbound direction of I-64 within the project limits.

In addition to the reduced speed limit, traffic impacts will be as follows:

- Weeknight east- and westbound single-lane closures, Sunday, February 19 through Friday, February 24, beginning as early as 7 p.m. and ending as late as 6 a.m. the following morning. One travel lane in each direction will remain open to traffic at all times. All construction work is dependent upon weather conditions.

WATA to Hold Public Hearings on New Demonstration Route

WILLIAMSBURG, Virginia (February 8, 2017) – Williamsburg Area Transit Authority (WATA) will hold several public hearings to receive community input on its proposed new demonstration route. The proposed route would provide service to locations including the JCC Government Complex, Lackey Free Clinic, Riverside Doctors' Hospital, VA Peninsula Regional Jail, and the Naval Weapons Station, among others, and would offer connection to Hampton Roads Transit via Lee Hall. More information about the route will be posted online at www.goWATA.org for the public to review prior to the meetings.
