

November 9, 2018 ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING

The York County Electoral Board was called to order at 10:06 a.m. to conduct the canvass of the November 6, 2018, General Election by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, General Registrar.

(Closed Session)

At 10:07 a.m. Chairman Rawls requested a motion to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots submitted for the November 6, 2018, General Election. Secretary Molineaux seconded. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 12:22 p.m. Chairman Rawls moved to return to open meeting session. Secretary Molineaux seconded the motion.

We certify that the York County Electoral Board convened a closed meeting on November 6, 2018, pursuant to an affirmative vote in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and that Section 2.2-3712 of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law.

The York County Electoral Board further certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed, or considered by the board in the closed meeting.

The Board voted to accept ballots as recorded in ballot record logs.
