The meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order on Monday, February 18, 2020, at 9:55 a.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were: Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, Registrar.

Also in attendance were David Olson and Tim Wyatt from York County ITT. The purpose of this meeting was to present to the Board a compliance overview of how York County stands on security procedures.
