

DRAFT June 11, 2021 Electoral Board Canvass Meeting

The canvass meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order on Wednesday, June 11, 2021, at 1:59 p.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were: Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, Registrar.

(Closed Session)

At 2:02 p.m. Richard Rawls moved to go into closed session to discuss provisional ballots. Sandy Molineaux seconded the motion.

(Open Session)

At 2:12 p.m. Phillip Wolf moved to go into open session. Sandy Molineaux seconded the motion.

We certify that the York County Electoral Board convened a closed meeting on June 11, 2021, pursuant to an affirmative vote in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and that Section 2.2-3712 of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law.
