A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND DR. ADAM A. FRISCH, DIRECTOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, Dr. Adam A. Frisch began his employment with the County as a GIS Manager on March 1, 1994, was promoted to Chief of Computer Support Services on July 1, 1997 and has held the position of Director of Information Technology since November 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch was placed in charge of the first centralized computer support division in York County’s history and has grown the former Division of Computer Support Services into the current Department of Information Technology that it is today; and

WHEREAS, He was responsible and accountable for the success of all information technology programs to include Geographic Information Systems, Enterprise Resource Planning system support, and IT technical support to all departments and agencies in York County Government; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch was responsible for directing and carrying out County policies and procedures relating to all phases of information technology programs and activities; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch freely shared his extensive knowledge and wisdom of all topics including technology, workflows, and County procedures with staff and citizens in a non-technical and easy to understand format; and

WHEREAS, He was well known for his dedication to and integrity of fiscal responsibility along with his effective negotiation capabilities; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch always led by example and supported his staff and fellow employees providing needed physical resources as well as guidance; and was known for his creative and effective analogies to communicate a wide array of topics; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch, as Chairman of the Steering Committee, successfully completed the implementation of the Tyler Munis Financial, Payroll, and Human Resources Enterprise Resource Planning system; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch created and implemented York County's technological vision since the centralization of computer support which included a single IT network, server virtualization, fiber optic connectivity, iPads, and remote work capabilities; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch successfully oversaw the rapid remote workforce adaptation during the beginning of 2020, facilitating hundreds of County employees to work safely from home in a matter of weeks; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch was recognized as an accomplished mediator among staff, departments, and agencies throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch collaborated with local government IT Directors across the state and served as the Treasurer for the Virginia Local Government IT Executives association; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frisch is highly respected throughout the County and exemplifies the highest quality of public service, setting an example for all County staff to strive towards. Mr. Frisch has earned the admiration and respect of the Board of Supervisors, and his colleagues for his professionalism, dedication, loyalty and exceptional work ethic; and
