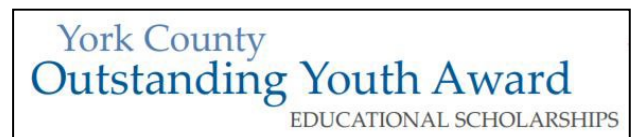
### Calling All Artists! Apply by February 1 for the Juried Art Show
