

DRAFT November 14, 2022 Electoral Board Canvass Meeting

The meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order on Monday, November 14, 2022, at 12:02 p.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were: Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; Sandy Molineaux, Secretary; and Walt Latham, Registrar. Also present was an observer, Republican Committee Chair Kitty Staskelunas.

(Closed Session)

At 12:06 p.m. Secretary Moliineaux moved to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots. Phillip Wolf, Vice Chair seconded the motion.

(Open Session)

At 6:15 p.m. Vice Chair Phillip Wolf moved to return to open session. Secretary Sandy Molineaux seconded the motion.

We certify that the York County Electoral Board convened a closed meeting on November 14,, 2022, pursuant to an affirmative vote in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and that Section 2.2-3712 of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law.
