As a result of Virginia's 1995 Crime Victim and Witness Rights Act, victims have the right to be notified upon a defendant's release from jail/prison. If a prisoner is being held in our local Virginia Peninsula Regional Jail and you wish to be notified of his/her release, you must request that notification in writing.
