SUBJECT: Update on Shentel Internet/Cable Service



As you may know, numerous inquiries have been received from residents regarding the projected timeline for the extension of internet/cable services in the County by Shentel. In response to these queries, Tim Wyatt, Director of Information Technology recently reached out to Shentel and obtained the latest update on this project which revealed that:

- 149 homes are construction complete and active.
- 737 homes are currently available for construction, with those starting between August 17, 2023 and September 29, 2023. The forecast for these to be active is between October 20, 2023 and November 30, 2023.
- 2,054 homes are in some stage of permitting, with construction commencing between November 2023 and February 1, 2024. These are scheduled to be online between January 24, 2024 and April 3, 2024.

Hopefully, the Board will find this information both interesting and helpful should you be approached by citizens seeking an update on this matter.
