Project Overview

Description

- In-Service: **Q2 2025**
- Location: **York County, Virginia**
- Site Description: Located on a previously developed site—former Navy underground fuel storage site.
- Entity: Dominion Energy Virginia (VEPCO)
- Acquisition: VEPCO acquired from KDC Solar Virginia

Facility

- System Capacity: **20 MWac| 26 MWdc**
- Land: ~250 leased acres from EVRIFA
- Permitting: CUP Approval: July 23, 2021

Kings Creek Solar is a solar acquisition project now owned by Dominion Energy. Dominion Energy included Kings Creek Solar in its third filing under the Virginia Clean Economy Act (VCEA) to the VA State Corporation Commission. In April 2023 the SCC approved the project and granted its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN), a state-level permit required to begin construction.
