SUBJECT: Notification of Certain Procurements: Pedestrian Access Improvements:
Sidewalks along Battle Road in Yorktown

In accordance with the Board's policy for the procurement of items in the County's approved Capital Improvements Program (CIP) involving the procurement of goods and services costing between \$50,000 and \$100,000, or when otherwise stipulated by a prior resolution, the staff is to notify the Board of such actions.

The pedestrian access improvement project includes sidewalks along Battle Road to improve pedestrian access and connectivity in the area, linking key locations such as the Yorktown Library and the existing York Convalescent Center. A public solicitation was conducted for General Maintenance and Construction Services. Resolution R22-149 was approved for a multi-year, term contract with Kerrick Construction, LLC.

The funding is included in the Capital Projects Fund and will cost \$498,016. This is the first phase of a two-phase sidewalk extension plan, which involves the construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Battle Road, covering a distance of 940 linear feet.

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
