I am writing in regard to the construction of eight proposed cluster homes between Faulkner Road and Country Lane. My name is Wayne Ditto and my wife is Sharon Ditto and we have lived at 403 Faulkner Rd since 1982 or over 42 years, and in that interim I have witnessed three new homes being built at the end of Faulkner and into the watershed in the back of Faulkner rd. How these single-family homes passed both sewage and water drainage interruption into the water shed or further out, I do not know. The wildlife habitat has either been destroyed or pushed beyond Faulkner and beyond Country Lane.

If the York County Planning Commission allows this concentrated construction of these eight homes, other than single, stand alone, family homes, the water shed will be further interrupted which feeds the Newport News Reservoir. Those animals essential to the eco and food chain will again be dramatically damaged if not destroyed. Add to this the increased road and utility construction and maintenance and the cost of allowing MORE homes into this already FULL neighborhood will only end up costing the county taxpayers more, and to what end? To make a few developers and investors richer?
