### OUR LATEST INITIATIVES

- Expanded **REVIVE!** training and Narcan distribution continue through **Project LEAD**. Since its creation in Jan 2023 to present, the Project Lead network has grown to 75+ community partners!
  - Oct 1, 2023 - Apr 17, 2024
    - Distributed 467 Naloxone Kits
    - Engaged with 935 people
    - Distributed 367 Fentanyl Test Strips
  - Organizations interested in receiving REVIVE! training should sign up on our website
- The **School Outreach Program** continues to increase knowledge of respiratory disease transmission, proper hand hygiene, and respiratory etiquette in students across Hampton and Peninsula Health Districts' localities. Number of children/students reached since initiative began in May 2023:
  - 1,616 students through the NNPS Preschool Program
  - 1,641 children/students at 56 different childcare facilities across both Hampton & Peninsula Health Districts.
- EP&R has been working on plan updates and completing the **Project Public Health Ready (PPHR)** training & recognition program to help local health departments build their preparedness capacity through a continued quality assurance process.
- The **Community Health Worker (CHW) Team** is busy attending various community events, kick-starting a health literacy program, and riding along with our Environmental Health Team to offer rapid REVIVE! training to hotel and motel staff. Organizations interested in having the CHW Team provide outreach at an event, should fill out the form on our website.
- HPHD is hosting a **Health and Wellness Expo on June 29, 2024 from 10am-3pm!** Come out for a day of fun and receive free wellness and social needs screenings, testing, vaccinations, Medicaid enrollment, presentations, kid's activities, and more!
