Creek Landing. And remember, the Yorktown Fishing Pier is always free to fish because the County holds the pier's fishing license.




Kalmar Nyckel Sails Into Town Next Week

Climb aboard this magnificent full-scale replica of the Swedish war ship that brought settlers to North America in 1638 and explore life as a 17th-century sailor. Plan ahead for public sails plus **free deck tours** courtesy of the Yorktown Tall Ship Committee and York County from 3 to 7 p.m. on Wednesday, June 12.

Early Voting Continues for June Primary

In-person, early voting for York County voters is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Registrar's Office locations in Washington Square Shopping Center and Victory Village Shopping Center. These locations will also be open tomorrow (6/8) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and next Saturday (6/15) for early voting. Ballot drop boxes are also available during these times and will be available Monday, June 17, from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Tuesday, June 18 (Primary Day), from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. On the ballot are Nominees for the U.S. House of Representative for the Democratic Party and Nominees for the U.S. Senate for the Republican Party. Stormwater Construction General Permit Holders in York County

The Virginia DEQ recently updated the Erosion and Stormwater Management ordinance, which affects anyone who holds a Stormwater Construction General Permit for any commercial developments (such as subdivisions). The County recently sent a letter to all of these permit holders, with a request to return the VAR10 Registration Statement selecting the "Existing Permit Reissuance" option. It is imperative that any permit holder that has not returned this statement do so as soon as possible, as an immediate stop work order will be issued on July 1 to any developer that has not returned the completed statement.
