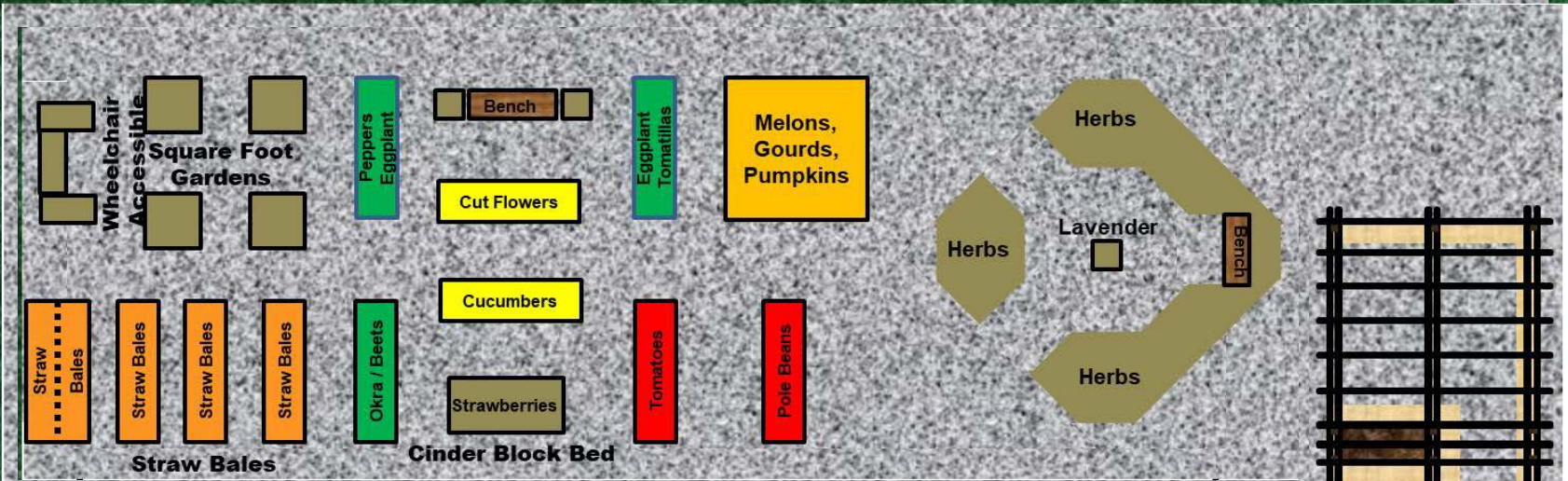


York/Poquoson Master Gardeners Learning Garden at the Poquoson Museum
