I hope all is well with you!

The USS Yorktown CG 48 Association is extremely grateful to the BOS for the beautiful Proclamation recognizing the service of the ship and crew! They plan to feature the Proclamation prominently in the upcoming 40th Anniversary Celebration of the Commissioning of the USS Yorktown CG 48 at the Ammunition Pier of the Naval Weapons Station Yorktown.

The Association would like to invite Chairman Roane and Vice Chairman Noll and other members of the BOS to present the Proclamation in person at one of the events of the 40th Anniversary Celebration. We know that the time of BOS members will be very limited during the period 18-19 Oct with events related to Yorktown Day 2024. Acknowledging the scheduling issues, we would like to propose two times that may work for the BOS.
