Subject: [EXTERNAL] Colonial Parkway Rehabilitation Project -- October 2024 Update

Greetings,

Parkway Rehabilitation Status:

In Segments D&E (*Felgates Creek to Penniman Road*): Crews continue with pavement demolition, subgrade improvement, and concrete placement.

In Segment A (*Ballard Street to Fusiliers Redoubt Ramp*): Deck and fascia girder forming continues at the Colonial Parkway Bridge over Route 17.

In Segment G (*Visitor Center Drive to Rt.199*): Pavement demolition, storm water utility installation, and subgrade improvement continues. Concrete and masonry repairs continue at the Williamsburg Tunnel and at the Lafayette/C&O Rail bridge over the Colonial Parkway. Contractor has also started streambed improvement work in Segment G south of the Newport Avenue bridge.

We appreciate your ongoing patience as we continue making progress with rehabilitating the Colonial Parkway, thanks to funding provided by the bipartisan Great American Outdoors Act.

*Based on FHWA recommendations, the use of full segment closures provides a faster overall project completion, a better-quality overall end product, a safer environment for construction workers and the traveling public and saves about \$1,000,000 in project costs.

Safety: All visitors are encouraged to pay attention to the information provided on the electronic variable message signs, as well as detour and caution signs. For everyone's safety, motorists should be on the lookout for construction workers, vehicles, equipment, and any traffic stoppages or lane closures along the Parkway.
