Good afternoon Gentlemen,

Hope you all are doing well. I have attached the requested safety study for the Goosley & Old Williamsburg Road intersection. Based on the review and information provided, the following is recommended:

Signage

- Install Dual Oversized STOP signs on the eastbound (Route 238 - Old Williamsburg Road) and westbound (Route 1020 – Old Williamsburg Road) approaches to the study intersection.
- Install Dual Oversized Advanced Warning STOP Ahead signage on the eastbound (Route 238 - Old Williamsburg Road) and westbound (Route 1020 – Old Williamsburg Road) approaches to the study intersection.
- Install Dual Oversized Stop signs northbound on Route 238 (Goosley Road). - Install Stop Sign southbound on Emily Road.
- Install Dual Yield Signs on the slip lane southbound onto Route 238 (Goosley Road).

Pavement Markings

- Install STOP AHEAD pavement markings eastbound (Route 238 - Old Williamsburg Road) and westbound (Route 1020 – Old Williamsburg Road) approaches to the study intersection.
- Refresh Intersection pavement markings and include the modification of the eastbound Old Williamsburg Road to be shared left/through with the receiving lane gore chevron marking removed such that the new receiving lane is aligned.

Other TCD's

- Install flex posts on Route 238 (Goosley Road) on the centerline markings within the functional area of the intersection past the southbound slip line for positive traffic control to ensure no wrong way entry to the slip lane.

This will reconfigure this intersection to be 4-way stop controlled which should help reduce accidents, reduce speeds through intersection and provide additional time to clear the intersection. This work is estimated to cost \$40,000 to \$50,000 and I recommend utilizing FY25 County Safety funding to perform this work. If you all are in agreement, I will plan to get this project on the schedule for this summer.
