New Traffic Pattern on Victory Boulevard as Road Work Begins



Road construction is now underway on Victory Boulevard (Route 171), and motorists traveling eastbound between George Washington Memorial Highway (Route 17) and Hampton Highway (Route 134) will notice a new traffic

pattern in place. As of October 12, eastbound traffic has shifted approximately three feet to the left to allow crews to build a new eastbound lane. In addition, a short-term right-lane closure will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. while a temporary concrete barrier is installed along the right shoulder. Drivers are encouraged to stay alert, follow posted signs, and use caution when traveling through the work zone. For more details, [visit the project page here](#).


