## Stay Alert for Utility Scams This Holiday Season

Dominion Energy is reminding customers to stay vigilant as utility scams tend to increase during the busy holiday months.

Scammers often rely on distraction and

urgency, using tactics such as threatening immediate disconnection, demanding instant payment, or requesting unusual payment methods like gift cards, wire transfers, or digital payment apps.

Dominion Energy emphasizes that it will *never* call to demand immediate payment, use aggressive or unverified contact methods, or show up without proper identification. If you receive a suspicious call or visit, hang up or turn the person away, verify your account directly through the Dominion Energy website or mobile app, and report the activity to help protect others. **Additional Notes for the Week....** The Lightfoot Park and Ride lot at 617 East Rochembeau Drive has officially reopened as of Friday, November 21, after completing extensive paving and reconstruction work. The project—initiated during the temporary closure in June 2025—features brand-new asphalt pavement, refreshed striping for 68 parking spaces (including three ADA-compliant spaces), five new bike racks, updated signage, improved lighting, and a newly installed stormwater management pond.
