Honor Our Fallen Heroes at Yorktown National Cemetery

On **Saturday, December 13**, the public is invited to pay tribute to fallen heroes during the Wreaths Across America event at the Yorktown National Cemetery. The ceremony begins at 12 p.m. and will involve placing commemorative wreaths on the resting places of our nation’s veterans, accompanied by the reading aloud of each hero’s name. Beginning at 11 a.m., the Yorktown Trolley will be used to provide shuttle service to the National Cemetery. Please note that parking is not available at the Yorktown National Cemetery, so participants will park at the Colonial



National Historical Park's Visitor Center or the York County Courthouse to board the shuttle. Shuttle service will end one hour after the event is over.

York-Poquoson Sheriff's Business Academy Registration Now Open

Local business owners, managers, faith-based organizations, and anyone responsible for workplace safety are invited to register for the York-Poquoson Sheriff's Business Academy, a free nine-week program designed to strengthen safety practices and connect participants with valuable crime-prevention resources. Held from February 3 to March 3, 2026, the academy meets on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 7–9 p.m. at the York-Poquoson Sheriff's Office. Sessions cover a wide range of topics—including patrol techniques, white-collar crime, robbery prevention, crisis management planning, 911 communications, and a 2.5-hour class on workplace violence. Participants must attend at least seven of the nine sessions to receive a Certificate of Graduation. The Academy is open to businesses located in York County or the City of Poquoson, and all participants must be 18 or older. [Register here.](#)
