On motion of _____, which carried ____, the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION TO FORMALLY REQUEST, PURSUANT TO VIRGINIA CODE § 29.1-744(E), THAT “NO WAKE” ZONES BE DESIGNATED BY REGULATORY MARKERS ON THE WATERWAYS IN YORK COUNTY AND TO FORWARD SAID REQUEST TO THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE RESOURCES FOR CONSIDERATION AND ACTION

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources promotes boating safety to minimize interference between various users of public waterways through a system of uniform regulatory makers; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said regulatory markers is to convey to the operators of small watercraft, without need for reference to charts or published regulations, the presence of areas where boating operations are, in some manner, restricted; and

WHEREAS, the York County Board of Supervisors has determined, subsequent to discussions with Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources officials and subsequent to providing an opportunity for public comment, that the re-establishment of “No Wake” designations and markers in three York County waterways thought to have been subject to such restrictions since 1970 and 1975, respectively, would be an appropriate technique to promote boating safety; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the York County Board of Supervisors, this the ____ day of _____, 20__, that its application for the establishment of “No Wake” designations and markers in the following County waterways be, and it is hereby, forwarded to the Department of Wildlife Resources for

review and action as deemed appropriate by the Department:

- Poquoson River
- Chisman Creek
- Goose Creek
- Back Creek
- Queens Creek
- Wormley Creek.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board acknowledges its obligation, as the applicant, to assume responsibility for all costs of establishing and maintaining such signs or other markers as may be approved by the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the listing and charting of the locations herein as “No Wake” markers and designations shall in no way affect the listing and charting of other regulatory markers such as “Swim Area” markers and designations.
