A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$88,000 IN PENINSULA EVICTION REDUCTION PILOT PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS AWARDED BY THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the mission of the Peninsula Eviction Reduction Pilot Program is to make evictions rare, brief, and humane and to create and bolster a network of diverse and coordinated community resources that provide financial housing assistance, stabilization assistance, case management, and other wraparound services to prevent evictions and extend housing stability for vulnerable populations; and

WHEREAS, the Peninsula Eviction Reduction Pilot Program is administered by the United Way of the Virginia Peninsula and funded by the Commonwealth of Virginia, with oversight by the Department of Housing and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the United Way of the Virginia Peninsula and the Peninsula Eviction Reduction Pilot Program serve citizens in the County of York and across the Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Board of Supervisors that grant awards greater than \$75,000 and procurement of goods and services by the County involving the expenditures of \$75,000 or more be submitted to the Board for its review and approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors for the County of York this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2026, that \$88,000 from the United Way of the Virginia Peninsula through funding provided by the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development is hereby accepted and appropriated in the County's Grant Fund, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Administrator be, and is hereby, authorized to do all things necessary and reasonable to implement the grant, including but not limited to issuing procurement contracts, executing and certifying necessary documents, and appropriating any additional funding for this grant should the opportunity arise.
