On motion of Mr. Green, which carried 5:0, the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF POQUOSON TO ADJUST AND RELOCATE THE COMMON BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE TWO JURISDICTIONS IN ORDER TO ELIMINATE UNCERTAINTY AS TO THE PHYSICAL LOCATION OF THE BOUNDARY AND CONFUSION REGARDING IN WHICH LOCALITY CERTAIN PROPERTY LIES AS SPECIFIED IN VIRGINIA CODE §15.2-3106 AND TO PETITION THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF YORK AND CITY OF POQUOSON FOR APPROVAL OF THE CHANGE PURSUANT TO VIRGINIA CODE §15.2-3107

WHEREAS, there currently exists some uncertainty regarding the physical location of the common boundary line between the County of York and the City of Poquoson and confusion in some locations regarding in which locality certain property lies; and

WHEREAS, York County and the City of Poquoson desire to enter into an agreement to adjust and relocate the common boundary to address this uncertainty and confusion; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator for the County of York and the City Manager for the City of Poquoson have engaged in discussions to facilitate an agreement to clarify the common boundary line between the localities; and

WHEREAS, based upon those discussions, the two localities have come to an agreement and wish to propose to the York County Board of Supervisors and the City Council for the City of Poquoson that the common boundary line be adjusted to the location set forth and described on the attached exhibit. The general description of the boundary is as follows: beginning at the southern end of Lambs Creek and continuing in a southerly direction for approximately 1600 feet, across East Yorktown Road in an easterly direction for approximately 1000 feet, then running southerly, generally paralleling Carys Chapel Road and running to the east of the Woods of Tabb subdivision, ultimately crossing Carys Chapel Road and terminating at Brick Kiln Creek and the Hampton City Line; and

WHEREAS, Virginia Code §15.2-3106 states that whenever any two or more localities wish to relocate or change the boundary line between them, the governing bodies of such localities may, by agreement, establish, relocate, or change such boundary line between them; and

WHEREAS, the York County Board of Supervisors has published an advertisement setting forth its intention to approve an agreement to adjust the boundary line as set forth above, has caused said advertisement to be published as required by Virginia Code §15.2-3107(A), and has provided notice of the proposed boundary agreement to affected property owners as required by Virginia Code §15.2-3107(B); and

WHEREAS, the York County Board of Supervisors wishes to authorize the County Administrator to enter into an agreement setting forth the proposed boundary line adjustment in a form to be approved by the County Attorney and to petition the Circuit Court for the County of York and City of Poquoson to approve the boundary agreement as provided for in Virginia Code §15.2-3108, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the York County Board of Supervisors this the 19th day of December, 2023, that the County Administrator is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Poquoson, in a form approved by the County Attorney, to adjust the common boundary between the County of York and City of Poquoson, and to petition the Circuit Court for the County of York and City of Poquoson for approval of the boundary agreement.
