Sandy Molineaux reports each precinct will be staffed with ten officials. We have a few new applicants who can work this primary. A request was made that notices be sent to party chairs asking for election official applicants. We can then vote on these new applicants at the May 19 board meeting.

DS200 – April 26 and 27, and April 28 (if needed).

Upon review of the Statement of Results form, a need to stress write-ins was identified. Walt Latham is to update the form.

Our Training Manual for election officials was discussed and approved by the Board.

The annual review of our Security Plan will be done in June.

A possible meeting with the York School Superintendent was suggested if he felt the necessity.
