

**YORK COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD
MEETING MINUTES
15 August 2017**

The regular monthly meeting of the York County Electoral Board was called to order on Tuesday, August 15, 2017, at 10:08 a.m. by Chairman Richard Rawls. Others present were Phillip Wolf, Vice-Chairman; and Walt Latham, Registrar. Sandy Molineaux joined at 10:17 a.m.

The minutes were read and approved with a minor edit.

Walt Latham met with the architect hired by the County concerning space study for each division. The Board agreed Walt should meet with County administration/ Board of Supervisors concerning immediate needs for 2020 Presidential Election.

The Board decided to keep capital C.I.P. for 2023.

The Board's Election Official Training Plan is under review.

The State Board of Elections is working on a revision of Provisional Ballot Logs.

Annual maintenance on the voting machines found two machines in need of repair.
