



Street Closures and Trolley Route Schedule for Yorktown Day on Wednesday, October 19

Vehicular access to the following streets in historic Yorktown will be restricted to residents and their guests on Wednesday, October 19, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.:

- Zweybrucken Road
- Bacon Street
- Smith Street
- Nelson Street
- Read Street
- Church Street
- Main Street

The Yorktown Trolley will deviate from its normal route to accommodate the parade and patriotic exercises commemorating the 235th anniversary of the Revolutionary War victory at Yorktown. The trolley will run from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. following this schedule:

- 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. – National Park Service Visitor Center to Yorktown Victory Center via Ballard Street to Water Street and return via Water Street and Ballard Street.
- 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. – (Return to normal route) National Park Service Visitor Center to the Yorktown Victory Center via Zweybrucken Road, Comte de Grasse Street, and Water Street and return via Water Street and Ballard Street.

All public parking areas in historic Yorktown will be open to the public with the exception of the following lots. Parking lot between Church Street and Read Street and behind the County Administration Center, 224 Ballard Street, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. due to parade activities.
