



SUBJECT: Emergency Operations Plan Re-Adoption

As required by the Commonwealth of Virginia, the County developed and has maintained an Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) for response to significant events/incidents, disasters, and/or large scale emergencies. As part of the County's ongoing operation, this plan, which consists of the "Basic Plan" and its supporting annexes, is reviewed regularly and kept current by County staff. Every four years the State requires the adoption/re-adoption of each local EOP. Staff maintains and updates the plan including revisions and additions, as necessary, to maintain compliance with applicable local, state, and federal requirements, planning guidance, and/or industry best practices. The revisions were primarily housekeeping in nature and are reflective of our current mode of operations. These revisions have been reviewed by the Virginia Department of Emergency Management.

Proposed Resolution R16-116 has been prepared for the Board's consideration to adopt the updated Emergency Operations Plan and to authorize the County Administrator and his designee(s) to maintain and revise the County Emergency Operations Plan on a regular basis and/or as required by the Commonwealth of Virginia and/or by the Federal Government. I recommend its adoption.
