



County Residents and Business Owners can register with York Alert for emergency updates

York County citizens and businesses are urged to sign up to receive emergency alerts from York Alert, a county program that uses state-of-the-art emergency notification technology. The system employs a Self-Registration Portal (SRP) so citizens can easily sign up and be notified in the event of an emergency. During registration, citizens are asked to specify their phone number and/or email address as their method of notification. This system is used only in times of significant emergencies (storm-related information, emergency public utility information, etc.). Citizens must register via the SRP located at www.yorkalert.com or www.yorkcounty.gov (click on the "York Alert" logo on the left-hand side of the homepage).



"Since implementing the program in 2014, we have registered many citizens interested in receiving these York County-specific emergency updates," said Terry Hall, York County's Director of Emergency Communications. "York Alert is another tool we can use to notify citizens of a significant emergency in their county and even in a specific geographic location within the county."
