



## Oyster Roast scheduled for Sunday, November 13

Visitors can expect fried, roasted and fresh shucked oysters and oyster stew, Virginia ham biscuits, and desserts from Carrot Tree. Plus, enjoy Americana music by Scattered Smothered & Covered, sample craft beer, sip wine from the Colonial Wine Trail, and taste fresh cider - all from Virginia. A representative from the Virginia Oyster Trail will discuss the oysters of Virginia and share the benefits of recycling oyster shells.
